The Des Moines Yacht Club reconfirms our "valid until revoked" reciprocal card (sent prior to this letter).

Our reciprocal rules may have changed slightly since our last printed information. Our reciprocal area is defined by the green striped area on the south side and at the west end of "A" Dock. There is approximately 100 feet of length for visiting boats. Power is available at a charge of \$4.00 per day. Registration is required with the DMYC Steward.

Our reciprocal dock is not open to visitors on major holidays, ie: Memorial Day, Independence Day or Labor Day. Our reciprocal dock is closed to visitors from Thanksgiving through January 1 every year.

Members in good standing with a reciprocal yacht club may visit for a maximum of 48 hours, or two nights. Visiting boats must fly their club burgee and have available if requested a current membership card. A maximum of three (3) vessels from any and all reciprocal clubs may visit at one time. Reciprocal is available on a first come basis. Boats with a beam greater than 14 feet or an overall length greater than 50 feet cannot be accommodated.

## RECIPROCAL INFORMATION

Welcome to Des Moines Yacht Club and the City of Des Moines, Washington, the "Waterland City!" We sincerely hope you will enjoy your stay with us.

The reciprocal privileges of our Club's facilities include dock tie up with water. Power at 30 amps is available for \$4.00 per day. Restrooms with showers, an ice machine and upstairs lounge with kitchenette are available in the DMYC clubhouse.

Reciprocal privileges are not extended on holiday weekends, ie: Memorial Day, Independence Day/4<sup>th</sup> of July, or Labor Day. Reciprocal privileges are not available from U.S. Thanksgiving through January 1.

Reciprocal privileges are extended to you based on the following conditions and the DMYC Reciprocal Regulations set forth as follows.

1. You must be a member in good standing with a Yacht Club or Boating Club that has a current Reciprocal Agreement with DMYC. You must have a current membership card available upon request and be flying your club burgee on your boat. Reciprocal dock space is on a first come basis, no more than a total of three (3) vessels from Reciprocal clubs may be using the dock at the same time.
2. All visitors must register with the DMYC Steward upon arrival. Keys to gates and the DMYC clubhouse are available with a refundable deposit of \$20 for each key. 30 amp power is available for \$4.00 per day. Please make sure the 30 amp power plug you are using is marked "DMYC" and not marked for a tenant's slip number on the North side of "A" dock. The Club Steward is located in the mobile home behind the clubhouse to the South and may be reached at 206 878 7220 or by using the call box located at the West side of the parking lot gate.
3. Reciprocal visitors are allowed a maximum of 48 hours (two nights) or moorage at the West end of the South side of "A" dock. The reciprocal area is defined by a green stripe along the dock, approximately 100 feet. In addition there are signs on the dock. The "main club" dock may be used temporarily while registering and obtaining keys from the Club Steward. Permission is
