We are pleased to offer reciprocal moorage at the Deception Pass Marina (formerly Cornet Bay Marina) 48°23.90' – 122°37.60' in exchange for reciprocal moorage at your location. Deception Pass Marina indents the north end of Whidbey Island off the southeast side of Deception Pass and is a great place to visit as well as a great stopover for boats returning from the Strait of Juan de Fuca. The marina is unique in that is a great place to duck into in case the Strait is too rough or if Deception Pass is moving too fast to exit to the Strait.

Marina facilities:

- Diesel, 92-octane gasoline, and propane
- Water and 30-amp shore power at the docks
- Provisioning supplies at reasonable prices
- Marine holding tank pump-out and Porta Potty dump on the dock
- Downtown Cornet Bay is 3 blocks away

Policy for use of facility:

- Reciprocal moorage is available on a first-come first-served basis
- Limited to moorage only (electricity not included)
- Maximum of 2 nights per year per boat
- Boats up to 45 feet maximum
- Maximum of two boats per night per yacht club
- You must fly your yacht club burgee
- Pay your moorage
- Send receipt and a copy of your current yacht club membership card to ERYC at the address above

This reciprocal agreement will remain in effect until revoked by either club.
