We wish to extend an invitation to you and your members to visit our facility this season. Our club is located on the southwest side of inner Quatermaster Harbor, Lat.N47*23.62' Long.W122*27.84' Reciprocal moorage is located on the east side of the float that is nearest shore, approached from the south side of the facility as you enter the area. Use caution at low tide. Limited rafting is permitted. All reciprocal moorage is on a first-come first-serve basis, and we request that you fly your club burgee while visiting us.

Reciprocal moorage is free for the first 48 hours and \$.25 per foot per day for additional days; maximum stay is 4 days a month. Electricity (30amp) is available at \$4.00 per day. After tying up, please go to the gray registration box which is located at the foot of the ramp. Fill out the form, include any electrical fee (if used) in the envelope and drop in the lower gray locked box. Club rules and regulations are posted near the registration box. The combination to the gate is written on a paper in the box. You'll also find a key to the heads. If you have any questions, please see our caretaker, Glenn McCormick, onboard SARA at slip B06.

It is requested that you respect the Private Property and beach to the north of our club and use the beach to the south for your pleasure and walking your pets.

Please plan to arrive between sunrise and sunset, check out by noon and limit noise after 10pm.

If coming as a group, please limit the number of boats to those which can be accommodated at the guest dock. With advance notice, the caretaker may be able to assign additional moorage in vacant slips.

There is no garbage service. Whatever you bring in, please take it with you when you leave.

Please do not dump garbage or discharge heads in the marina. Our clubhouse deck and heads are available for use.

If your club desires to utilize our facilities for a club sanctioned cruise, please contact our Rear Commodore to schedule such use as special rules apply and Board approval is required.

We hope you enjoy your visit and extend best wishes to you and your members for a pleasant and safe boating season.
